The Jamboree Registration Fee and Payment

On 26 April 2022, an invoice for the deposit was sent to each Head of Contingent and NSO, and the revised payment schedule for the Jamboree registration fee is as follows:

- 10% surcharge on deposit: from 21 May 2022
- Deadline for deposit payment: 19 October 2022
- 10% surcharge on balance: from 1 March 2023
- Deadline for balance payment: 31 May 2023

Congratulations to the NSOs who have confirmed their participation by completing the deposit payment.

If the deposit is paid after 20 May 2022, 10% of the deposit will be added. A new invoice will not be issued, and payment can be made using the invoice that has already been sent.

Additionally, if the deposit is not paid by 19 October 2022, the registration will automatically be cancelled. Additional registration after the deposit payment deadline will only be considered in special cases and there is no guarantee of acceptance.

For the convenience of NSO Contingents, we are pleased to inform you that payments in USD are also possible. Please refer to the information provided in the invoice for how to pay in USD.

You can pay the full amount of the deposit and a part of the balance first. If you would like to make a payment, please contact wsjfee@scout.or.kr.

Policy on Refunds

The only instance where a refund can be made is when visa issuance is denied by the Korean government. In such a case, relevant evidence should be submitted. Refunds will not be considered if a participant is denied their visa to attend the Jamboree because the individual did not follow the application procedures, deadlines, or processes as outlined by the relevant government authorities.

There will not be any refund considerations if the Host Organization has no other choice but to request to the World Scout Committee to cancel the Jamboree due to force majeure. However, an exception will be considered only if the Korean Ministry of Health and Welfare guidance is that, due to the re-proliferation of COVID-19, it is not safe to run the event, a partial refund will be calculated after deduction of the costs incurred by the Host to procure items and equipment in reparation of the



However, please understand, in the worst case scenario that we are forced to cancel the event, the amount of the partial refund is dependent on the timeline, it is impossible to estimate the exact amount in advance.

The Pre-Jamboree

We plan to hold a Pre-Jamboree as part of our efforts to prepare for a successful Jamboree. It will be operated in compliance with the COVID-19 quarantine guidelines, so please understand that its method of operation may be different from the 25th World Scout Jamboree. Currently, self-quarantine is exempted only when full vaccination is completed before entering the country, so please check the attached precautions when entering the country.

▲ Theme: Imagining Your Dream

▲ Size of the event: 1,000 people

▲ Period: Tuesday 2 to Sunday 7 August 2022

* Arrival of participants: Tuesday 2 August / Departure: Monday 8 August

* Arrival of ISTs: Sunday 31 July / Departure: Monday 9 August

▲ Location: Area near the Global Leadership Center within the Jamboree site, SaeManGeum

▲ Eligibility

- Scouts: scouts aged 14 to 17
- Leaders: Scout leaders over the age of 18
- IST: Scout leaders able to communicate in English or French

▲ Fee: Scouts and leaders USD 200 / IST USD 100

- Deadline for payment of participation fee: 30 June 2022.
- Participation fee non-refundable, though individual participants can be changed
- Individual supplies that will be provided: ID card, scarf, T-shirt, badge, hat, woggle
- Supplies for each unit: tent, shade (tarp), outdoor table, chair, bamboo for gateway

▲ How to apply

1. Fill out Appendix 2-4 and write to prejam@scout.or.kr by 30 May 2022
2. The schedule for the pre-jamboree registration system will be announced later.

HoC Study Visit

HoC STUDY VISIT for the preliminary inspection of the 25th World Scout Jamboree site will be held from Wednesday, 3 to Saturday 6 August 2022 in Jeollabuk-do, Korea.

During that period, we plan to share the progress of the 25th World Scout Jamboree, conduct inspections of the Jamboree site and more, and run a question and answer session for each area of interest.

To note is that this event will allow you to check the progress of the Jamboree all the while sharing experiences with Pre-Jamboree participants, where you will be able to stay in tents, eat the same meals, and participate in on and offsite activities.

As such, the participation fee for the HoC Study Visit is USD 200 per person, which is the same as the participation fee for the Pre-Jamboree, and the schedule for the registration and participation fee payment is as follows:

- Application for participation (see attached): 31 May 2022
- Registration of participants' information: 31 May 2022
- Issuance of invoice: by 10 June 2022
- Payment deadline: Until 30 June 2022

If you need to stay at a hotel for special reasons, we plan to make a reservation for offsite accommodations(rooms) on a first-come, first-served basis, so please specify the accommodation information when filling out [the google questionnaire](#) with the participants' information, and contact [the website](#) and the company (+82-(0)63-469-1234) for more details.

In this regard, external accommodation and transportation costs (excluding officially scheduled accommodation ↔ Jamboree site transportations) are not included in the participation fee, so you will have to pay individually.

In addition, the Incheon International Airport plans to provide free vehicles for round-trip transportation between the airport and the Jamboree site, so please enter your arrival time at Incheon International Airport on 3 August and whether you will take the bus on 6 August.

▲ Quarantine-Free Travel to Korea from 23 May 2022

Note that these regulations are subject to change by the designated public health authorities and we will do our best to keep you informed of any changes but please review all current travel regulations before departure.

○ **Vaccination requirement**

- Fully vaccinated with WHO Emergency Use Listing (EUL) vaccines with the 2nd dose taken between 15 to 180 days of departure.
- If the 2nd dose was taken more than 180 days ago, booster dose is required.
- A person who contracted COVID-19 after receiving 2 doses of vaccine can be considered as fully vaccinated without taking the booster dose if he/she can provide a proof of recovery for verification.

○ **Pre-departure PCR Test**

Travel from 23 May 2022 onwards: Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) taken at a hospital or clinic within 1 day of departure OR Pre-departure PCR test taken within 2 days of departure will be accepted. Remote supervised ART / Tele-ART will not be accepted.

○ **Register for Q-Code**

Travellers (including Korean nationals) must upload their vaccination records and pre-departure PCR test result onto [Q-Code System](#) prior to departure. A QR code will be issued to the traveller's email after registration.

○ **Take an On-Arrival PCR Test**

PCR test (self-paying) to be taken at Incheon Airport. It costs KRW 120,000(around USD 100).
